

COOKIES NOTICE & POLICY

1. INFORMATION ABOUT OUR USE OF COOKIES

- **1.1** Our website (our "site") is operated by United Malt Group (company number 140 174 189) whose registered office is Level 28, 175 Liverpool Street, Sydney, NSW 2000, Australia ("we", "us", "our"). The site uses cookies to distinguish you from other users and this helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our site and also to improve our site.
- **1.2** If you wish to remove cookies placed on your device by our site or stop our site placing further cookies on your device, you can do this at any time (learn how to do this below).
- **1.3** A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive. We use the following cookies:
- **1.3.1** Strictly necessary cookies

These are cookies that are required for the operation of our site. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of our site or make purchases. We do not require your consent to place these cookies. Nevertheless, you may be able to block these cookies yourself on your device/ browser, but restricting these cookies is likely to mean that our site will not work as you would expect and certain functionality may be inoperable.

- **1.3.2** Non-essential cookies
 - a) Analytical/performance cookies. They allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our site when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our site works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily. We use cookies to compile visitor statistics such as how many people have visited our site, how they reached our site, what type of technology they are using (e.g. Mac or Windows which helps to identify when our site isn't working as it should for particular technologies), how long they spend on the site, what page they look at etc. This helps us to continuously improve our website. All information these cookies collect is aggregated and therefore anonymous. If you do not allow these cookies we will not know when you have visited our site and will not be able to monitor its performance.
 - b) Functionality cookies. These are used to recognise you when you return to our site. This enables us to personalise our content for you, greet you by name and remember your preferences (for example, your choice of language or region).

1.4 You can find more information about the individual cookies we use and the purposes for which we use them in the table below:

_ga	2 year(s)	This cookie is used to distinguish unique users by assigning a randomly generated number as a client identifier. It is included in each page request in a site and used to calculate visitor, session and campaign data for the sites analytics reports.	Google Analytics Analytical / Performance Cookie
_gid	24 hour(s)	This cookie is used to group the user behavior together for each user. Structure of its value is very similar to _ga cookie.	Google Analytics Analytical / Performance Cookie
cusid	30 Minute(s)	This cookie is used to distinguish unique user sessions to track page visits on the site for up to 30 minutes.	ClickDimensions. Analytical / Performance Cookie

- **1.5** Please note that third parties (including, for example, advertising networks and providers of external services like web traffic analysis services) may also use cookies, over which we have no control. These cookies are likely to be analytical/performance cookies or targeting cookies.
- **1.6** You can block cookies by activating the setting on your browser that allows you to refuse the setting of all or some cookies. However, as set out above, if you use your browser settings to block all cookies (including essential cookies) you may not be able to access all or parts of our site. For instance, our site, like most websites, includes functionality provided by third parties. A common example is an embedded video powered by YouTube and Vimeo. Disabling all cookies may mean you cannot access the functions offered by these third parties.
